Title: EC Discipline Policy

The Board recognizes its obligation to comply with applicable state and federal laws concerning the education of students with disabilities, including the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act ("IDEA"). For each charter school operated by the Board, the conduct of all students, including students with disabilities, will be governed by the school's Code of Conduct. Additionally, school personnel will comply with the applicable provisions of the North Carolina Policies Governing Services for Children with Disabilities (NC 1504-2). School personnel may consider any unique circumstances on a case-by-case basis when determining whether a change in placement, consistent with the other requirements of NC Policies, is appropriate for a child with a disability who violates a provision of the Code of Conduct. Circumstances considered should include area of disability, functioning level of the child, intent of the behavior, and other relevant factors.
